FCDC has a group called PALs (Parents As Leaders) comprised of current parents of children attending FCDC. The purpose of PALs is to foster a sense of community between families and staff.

What does the PALs Team do?

PALs team members discuss topics of interest to FCDC families including our policies and programs. They provide a parent perspective to FCDC's decision-making. The team also organizes center-wide events so FCDC families can interact and get to know one another. In the past, the team has organized the summer Family Picnic and volunteered during various fundraisers and center projects. They have also help organize teacher appreciation efforts like our Holiday Collection and Teacher Appreciation Week.

How to Pals members communicate?

FCDC hosts a Goolge Group forum that allows members to be notified of upcoming events, post topics and contribute to conversations at their own leisure. As time allows, members can also opt to organize meetings to discuss or work on various projects in person.
